I understand that if I am awarded an APABA-CO Scholarship, I must be enrolled and in good standing at least half-time at The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law or Capital University Law School at the time of award.

I understand that I must comply with all stated policies and conditions of the, Scholarship, and that the funds awarded are to be used only for tuition, course-related expenses, reasonable living expenses while enrolled in law school, or student loans.
